

New Georgia Hunting Club Rules 2020 - 2021

1. Be considerate of club members who have stands by the roads! Do not drive any vehicles on club land between 6:30 am & 11:00am during any hunting season unless, you need to remove a deer! All ATV traffic should be held to a minimum during deer season.

Do not enter other members' areas without the permission of that member!

2. Obey all state hunting rules with the following exception: until further notice, each member will be allowed a maximum of seven (4) deer consisting of two (2) bucks and Two(2) does. **Both (2) bucks must have at least four (4)points (1) inch long on one (1) side. Any Buck Not Meeting The Minimum Will Result In A \$200.00 Fine. Fine Must Be Paid Immediately After Kill. Killing A Button Buck Will Result In A \$200.00 Fine. All Deer Killed Must Be Reported To An Officer Immediately! A Member Over 70 And Been A Member For More Than 10 Consecutive Years May Go By State Regulations.**

3. Any member may bring his children & grandchildren hunting free of charge provided the child's 18th birthday falls after November the 30th. All children & grandchildren are required to hunt with an adult member. Wives may hunt free.

4. No small game hunting during deer season.

5. Members not reporting to at least one (1) workday during the hunting year will have to pay a **\$50.00** fine to take care of their part of the work or the Officers can assign you a work detail.

6. No building permanent stands after bow season opens. No building permanent stands on Pat Green. Absolutely no nails in pine trees. No leaving trash around stands or anywhere except in receptacles.

7. All dues/fees are due May 15th after which openings will be filled. hardships must be approved by the Officers . Any member late may be put on Probation for one year and will have to pay his dues on **May 15th** the next year

8. Approved hardships: After the Board of Directors approval... children of hardship cases, may hunt with an overseeing member. The deer killed will be taken off of the overseeing members deer availability.

9. Each member can have two (2) stands for his personal use. No other hunter may hunt in the area of another. Members can only trade stands if the members are in good standing with the club.(All dues , fines & fees paid in full)

10. It is required for all stands to be distanced 333 Yards from another hunter's stand on the power lines and 233 Yards in the woods.
